Then I hit on the idea of the characters moving to the London area, this way I could write what I knew about.

The story has a Scottish twist and brings to attention the challenges that faced families with young children when they decided to up their roots for a better life.

I finished writing the sequel in May 2008 but I made another decision to change my publisher. This time around I only emailed a dozen publishers and got immediate interest. The end result was that I signed a wonderful contract with Pneuma Springs Publishing in Kent.

"Chasin' That Carrot", it is a fiction story but as in "What's For Ye, Won't Go by Ye", I have created it from people in general living in that era and I am sure that anyone reading it will see a likeness in some of them from someone they remember from the past.
